




Introduction-RRCN

General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM)

General Nursing & Midwifery course is aimed at preparing the students who will have sound theoretical knowledge, skilled in nursing practice and able to provide holistic nursing care to sick and well. They will be prepared to practice standard nursing.

Our objectives is to provide high standards of education by adopting holistic approach. To develop knowledge, skills, attitude and aptitude in giving comprehensive care to the clients to manifest physical, social and mental conditions. Also to demonstrate competence in Nursing skills, techniques and participate, co-operate and Co-ordinate as a member of health team in promotion, prevention and restoration of health.

Admission Eligibility

Age

Minimum age for admission will be 17 years (as on 31st December of that year), the upper age limit is 35 years. FOR ANM, LUV-No age bar.

Selection:

- 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board, Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government However science is preferable.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre
- Registered ANM with pass mark.

B.Sc Nursing (Basic)

It is an undergraduate programme designed to Prepare graduates to assume responsibility as professional, competent nurses and midwives in providing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative services to all who needs nursing care.

Prepare nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing situations, protect the rights and facilitate individual and groups in pursuit of health, function in hospital, community Health Nursing services, and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice. They are also expected to assume role of teacher, supervisor, and manager in clinical or public health setting.

Admission Eligibility

Age:

The candidate should have completed 17 years on or before 31st day of December of the year of admission.

Selection:

Selection of the candidates should be based on the merit in the entrance examination held by University or competent authority.

B.Sc Nursing (Post Basic)

It is also an undergraduate programme for those who have undergone the diploma in general nursing and midwifery course, and already providing their nursing services in hospital, health centers and public health setting to get an opportunities degree in nursing. The course is specifically directed to the upgrading of critical thinking skills, competencies and request for practice of professional nursing and midwifery.

The course is intended to enable the graduates:-

- To make independent decision in nursing situations, protect the rights of individual client.
- To facilitate individual and groups to pursuit of health, function in the hospital, community health nursing services, and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice.

Admission Eligibility

Hold a diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM)

Have passed pre university examination in arts /science /commerce conducted by Department of Pre University Education, Karnataka State or its equivalent recognized by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences.

Age

No candidate who is above 48 years of age on31st December of the year of admission shall be eligible.





M.Sc Nursing

This is a post graduate programme designed to prepare nurses for leadership position in nursing and health fields who can function as nurse specialist, consultants, educators, administrators and researchers in a wide varieties of professional settings in meeting the national priorities and the changing needs of the society. This programme provides an opportunity to post masteral programmes in nursing and doctoral studies in nursing.

Admission Eligibility

Passed B.Sc Nursing (Basic) or Post Basic B.Sc in Nursing degree or Post Certificate B.Sc Nursing of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka (RGUHS), or any other University expected as equivalent by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka.

Minimum of one year of experience after obtaining B.Sc Nursing (Basic) in a Hospital or in Nursing Educational Institution or Community Health setting.

Registered in State Nursing Council as registered Nurse and registered Midwife /psychiatric Nurse.

To fulfill the requirement of above nursing courses and our college has well equipped faculty, classrooms and laboratories in the college i.e., Nursing foundation, Medical surgical nursing, Child health nursing, Obstetrics and gynecology nursing, Community health nursing, Nutrition, Computer labs and well furnished library.

Laboratory Hands-on Experience









NURSING FOUNDATION - LAB

Nursing foundation course is designed to help the students to develop and understanding the philosopy, objective, theories and process of nursing in various clinical settings. For which we have well equiped lab with 10 beds.

MEDICAL SURGICAL NURSING - LAB

Medical Surgical Nursing course is designed to help the students to acquire knowledge and develop proficiency. The various skills related to medical and surgical conditions, performing related nursing procedures will be taught as first hand experience in the lab combined with nursing foundation lab.

CHILD HEALTH NURSING - LAB

This lab provides solid foundation for peadiatric nursing i.e. first hand experience to handling neonates and children with the help of simulated model (manikins) and also performing related nursing procedures, before going to actual clinical settings.

MIDWIFERY AND OBSTETRICAL NURSING - LAB

This laboratory provide first hand experience in assessment of antenatal case, intranatal case, post natal case, neonatal assessment and demonstration of nursing care and handling problems accordingly.

MENTAL HEALTH NURSING - LAB

This laboratory is equipped with prepared models related to mental health and illness, various models, flash cards, flipcharts are also available for enhancement of learning. A series of counseling and guidance programme also available for students in the department.



COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING - LAB

This course is designed for the students to develop an understanding of the recent modern approach to appreciate the principles of promotion and maintain of health and also identification, This laboratory, equipped with community bags, for learning bag techniques, and various audiovisual aids related to community health concern

NUTRITION LAB

This is a separate lab equipped with various models, posters, flash cards, flip charts for nutrition education and also various vessels and accessories to prepare different receipe according to different kinds of food for different illness.

COMPUTER LAB

This course designed for students to develop basic understandings of the use of computers and its applications in nursing. This computer lab attached to the library and has facilities to access various journals through helinet.

LIBRARY

The Central Library stocks more than 10,000 books of various subjects in medical and allied health sciences. Reputed journals, both Indian and foreign are available in departmental libraries. The total number of books in the central and departmental library runs over 10,000 titles.
